

COURSE BUNDLING

With Course Bundling, you can bundle a group of courses together so that enrollment in one course will automatically provide enrollment in all the courses in the bundle.

Administrators decide on the name of the course bundle and the individual courses that make up the bundle. At a later time, you can add additional courses to the bundle.

Course Bundling is designed to integrate with the CampusPay e-commerce platform, which allows for online payments by credit card or PayPal.

Steps

1. Create a Course Bundle course
2. Add Courses to the Bundle
3. Define Pricing
4. Test

Suggested Bundles

- One Bundle with Many Courses – used to offer discounts for multiple course purchases
- Several Bundles of One Course or One Set of Courses – used to offer tiered pricing
